



# Bayport Container Terminal

## FACT SHEET

- Terminal opened for operation in January 2007.
- A total of 33 construction contracts awarded or authorized and funded; with the longest one set for completion in September.
- Phase 1A footprint to cover 90 acres of the 1,043-acre facility.
- To be built out in phases over 15 to 20 years to meet market demand.
- Will have enough space for seven ships and a 378-acre container storage yard.
- Will have a maximum capacity of about 2.3 million TEUs (twenty-foot equivalent units, the standard of measurement in the maritime shipping industry) – a 200 percent increase over PHA's current container handling capacity.
- Noise mitigation and environmental activities unique to the construction at Bayport include: monitors positioned around the perimeter of the construction site to track noise and any dust that might be generated on-site. This information helps the contractors plan activities that will remain below the noise threshold established by local ordinances and to ensure extensive dust control. PHA also working with the primary contractor to increase the number of heavy equipment vehicles with special noise reducing backup alarms to 132, to reduce annoyance in the surrounding communities
